1. Western District Moravian Youth Camp Fund Voucher

The Moravian Youth Camp Fund was created by a gift from persons interested in promoting attendance by youth at Western District church camps. Its purpose is to reduce camp fees and thereby enable a larger group to benefit from the camp experience. You do not have to be a Moravian to receive these funds, they are automatically being applied when you register. The fund is administered by the Western District Executive Board.
